### **Have Multiple ideas for camps?**

Each camp requires its own proposal form, even if the teacher is the same. You can submit as many proposals as you like. Teachers frequently teach multiple weeks of camp.

### **Camp times:**

Students meet from 8:30am-12:00pm for the morning classes and 1:00pm-4:30pm for afternoon camps. We ask that teachers commit to arriving at least 30 min prior to each day for preparation/setup and stay until the cleanup checklist is complete.

### **General Info:**

Most classes have a 3–5-year age range with a capacity of 20 students. You will have an assistant all week. Curriculum should be geared to accommodate your selected age range. We host a diversity of offerings focusing in the following areas: visual arts, writing, film and media, performing arts, heritage and culture, and design. Be creative and use your expertise. Classes which include STEAM or Social/Emotion Learning components are encouraged.

### **Pay:**

Teachers will receive 50% of the class fee for each student which can be up to \$1750.00 for a fully enrolled 20 student camp. Camps must have at least 6 enrolled students to run.

### **Steamboat Creates takes care of:**

- Enhancing marketing
- Registrations and liability forms
- Providing an art assistant to help with your camp and sign-in/sign-out procedures
- Helping you flesh out your project ideas
- Providing the Create Space art pantry for supply needs
- Providing a small budget for some material costs
